Case 20-4057: Mike Baker, on behalf of Sheila and Joseph Robertson, has applied for a variance to reduce a front setback from 60' to 15' and to reduce a side setback from 30' to 10', both to construct a 24' x 28' detached garage. The subject property is located at 3135 Tobacco Road, Chesapeake Beach (Tax Map 19, Parcel 194, Lot 5) and is zoned Farm and Forest District (FFD.) [APPLICATION](#)

Case 20-4055: Theodore Haynie has applied for: a Special Exception for expansion of a pre-existing non-conforming accessory structure with deck; a Critical Area variance for disturbance of the 30' Critical Area buffer as required for an approximately 4' encroachment by the aforementioned deck; and for a Non-Critical Area variance to reduce the side setback from 6' to 2' to accommodate another accessory structure approximately 12.8' x 10.3' in size. The subject property is located at 200 Langley Lane, Solomons (Tax Map 44B, Parcel 98) and is zoned Solomons Town Center Subarea C6, Critical Area Intensely Developed Area (TC, IDA).
