### **Calvert County Visitor Information Centers Move to Seasonal Schedule**

**PRINCE FREDERICK, Md.** – October 28, 2011 – From November 1 to December 31, 2011, Calvert County's two visitor information centers located in Owings and Solomons will operate under seasonal hours and be open on Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Knowledgeable staff are available at each location to provide information about local attractions, hotels, restaurants and other travel information.

The Owings center is co-located with the Fairview Library at 8120 Southern Maryland Boulevard; in Solomons, the center is located at 14175 Solomons Island Road South.
