New Calvert County Business Fills a Void for Trailer Owners

PRINCE FREDERICK, Md. – Oct. 11, 2013 – The sign out front says “Trailer Parts.” Inside, there is so much more.

Centreville Manufacturing Inc. now has a Prince Frederick retail location where the company sells just about any part that could be needed for a trailer. The retail location is just one component of the entire company; the original factory location makes custom trailers for everything from speed cameras to highway signs. Owner John Doran employs 25 people at locations in Centreville, Md., Annapolis and now Prince Frederick.

Doran originally opened Centreville Manufacturing in 1999, when he purchased an established trailer manufacturing company. At first he mainly operated the factory.

“As a manufacturer, we had a lot of parts and people needed a place to go and buy the parts,” Doran said. He opened the store in Annapolis five years ago and started hearing that there was a demand for another store in Southern Maryland. He chose the Prince Frederick location as a central site to serve Southern Maryland.

“We put up the sign that says ‘Trailer Parts’ and that’s been very effective,” said Andy Juskelis, manager of the Prince Frederick store. “People don’t have to guess what our business is.” Juskelis said the business fills a void because people who own trailers often have to go to various places to make any needed repairs.

“When you see a trailer on the side of the road being held up by a rock, you know those people need a place to buy trailer parts,” he said. “If somebody breaks down, I would say the odds are good that we’ve got what they need on the shelves.”
