

**FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADDRESSING PUBLIC HEALTH,
SAFETY AND WELFARE CONCERNS AND STORM DEBRIS**

WHEREAS, Friday, July 27, 2018, Calvert County experienced severe winds, and rain that caused trees to be uprooted or felled, power outages and disruption of services in Calvert County, and micro-bursts of wind within the Chesapeake Ranch Estates community;

WHEREAS, these conditions that exist beyond the passage of that storm create life-threatening conditions throughout Calvert County, including the increased risk of the spread of fire and impediments to the passage of emergency equipment;

WHEREAS, the Property Owner's Association of Chesapeake Ranch Estates, Inc. has undertaken clean-up of storm debris;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County desires to, if it is not obligated to, assist in the removal of storm debris to preserve community health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County expects that the opening of the Appeal Landfill for yard waste disposal at no charge to the Property Owner's Association of Chesapeake Ranch Estates, Inc. will mitigate the increased risk of the spread of fire and impediments to the passage of emergency equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County that the tipping fee for Yard Waste related to the storm will be waived for the Property Owner's Association of Chesapeake Ranch Estates, Inc. from July 27, 2018 through August 7, 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that this Resolution shall be retroactively effective July 27, 2018.




