Emily Walker-PRISM	Needs to be independent of police; remove law enforcement from board; need transparency; timing of meetings need to ensure all can participate including the use of virtual meetings and recording the meetings so other can watch later
James Thiel	Police are not trained to be respectful or sensitive; no law enforcement or affiliation with law enforcement or law enforcement background on board; those experiencing law enforcement should be on PAB; open meetings and full transparency; need mental health and healing on board
Antoine White	not all police are bad; need to be citizens of the community; no oversight from BOCC
Mike Shisler	crowd is less; 2nd draft improved; "extent practicable" need to be removed from membership criteria; ensure 50% female membership; transparency; need to be readable and understandable in plain English and needs to be equitable
Larry Lamson	training listed is sufficient; background checks preferred; diversity is fair compromise
