PERTAINING TO THE SETTING OF FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE DIVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH, CALVERT COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, is *ex officio* the Board of Health for Calvert County, pursuant to Section 3-201, *Health-General Article*, Maryland Annotated Code;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-202(c) of the *Health-General Article*, <u>Maryland Annotated Code</u>, the County Board of Health has authority to set fees and charges;

WHEREAS, the Health Officer has recommended changes to the fees and charges currently in effect for the Health Department;

WHEREAS, by the authority of the Board of County Commissioners, notice of a public hearing was duly advertised and conducted on November 29, 2022 to allow public comment on the adoption of proposed fees and charges; and

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the testimony of the public hearing and the comments of staff and the public, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that, adoption of the Calvert County Health Department the Schedule of Fees and Charges attached hereto as Exhibit A is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Calvert County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland, that the Schedule of Fees and Charges attached hereto as Exhibit A, **BE** and hereby **IS**, adopted for the services rendered by the Division of Environmental Health of the Calvert County Health Department;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that, annually, on July 1 of each year following adoption of this Resolution, those fees set forth in Exhibit A hereto shall be adjusted for inflation equal to resulting new fee being the fee adopted herein times a fraction, the numerator of which is the revised Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index for all Items and Major Group Figures for All Urban Consumers, U. S. City Average (1982-84=100) (the "Index") for December of the preceding year and the denominator of which is the Index for December, 2022;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that all previously adopted fees inconsistent with those set forth in Exhibit A hereto, including, without limitation, those set forth in Resolutions 91-87 and 25-92, are repealed upon this Resolution becoming effective;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, Maryland that the foregoing recitals are adopted as if fully rewritten herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said schedule shall be effective on January 1, 2023 following recordation and publication of a fair summary.
